



Wetlands in My Eyes Writing Competition

Introduction

The Writing Competition is co-organised by Hong Kong Wetland Park of Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department, Education Bureau Yuen Long District School Development Section, Hong Kong Professional Teachers' Union and Ming Pao Newspapers Limited. The competition aims to encourage public to take a closer look at wetland environment, and to express their views on the relationship of wetland conservation and our health through writing. The competition also serves as training for logical thinking and writing skills.

Categories and Words Limit

Primary Group	: P.1 to P.4	(within 300 words)
Lower Secondary	: S.1 to S.3	(within 500 words)
Upper Secondary	: S.4 to S.7	(within 800 words)
Open Group	: Public	(within 1,200 words)

Language – Chinese

20 October to 15 December 2007 (by 17:00)

- Hand Writing: Write on a 400 words essay paper using BLUE or BLACK ball pen.
- Word Processing: Double-lined spacing with font size 12. Both scanned copy and soft copy (in MS Word/PDF format) of the essay should be attached in the e-mail.

Remarks: Artwork is not required.

- Results will be announced in mid-January 2008 at HKWP website. Winners will be informed individually by letters to attend the World Wetlands Day Celebration Ceremony on 2 February 2008.
